- I will participate in both academic and at least one extra-curricular activity by providing my parents/ all notices and information sent home from the school.

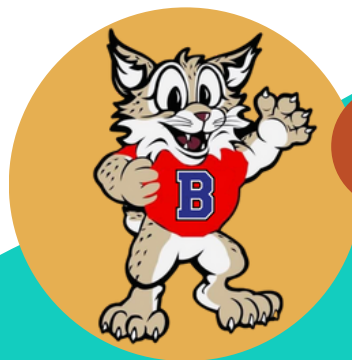
