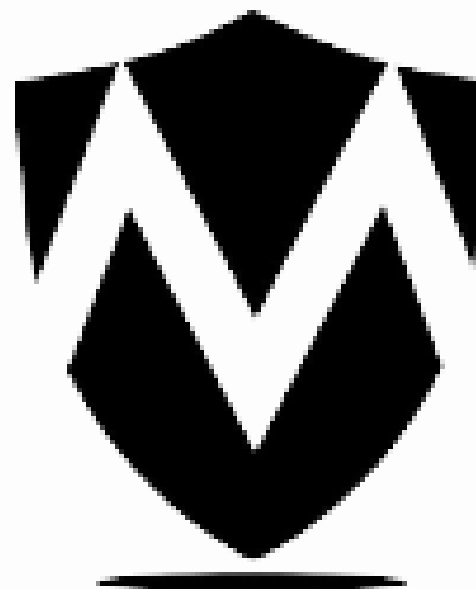
Our Mission

Do my homework everyday and turn assignments in when they are due.

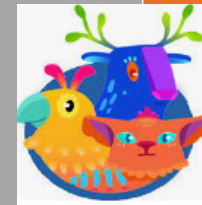
