

The G/T Assessment & Identification target audience for the 2023-2024 school year includes Universal Screening of:

- Kindergarten and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students who are not already identified as gifted/talented;
- Students scoring Masters Grade Level on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) and End of Course (EOC) assessment not already identified as gifted/talented;
- Students scoring in the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile on EOY MAP assessment not already identified as gifted/talented;
- 7<sup>th</sup> graders and 9<sup>th</sup> graders enrolled in advanced courses who are not already identified as gifted/talented;
- Emergent Bilingual Students enrolled in Dual Language, Spanish for Spanish Speakers I and II, and Advanced Placement Courses and who are not already identified as gifted/talented; and
- Any referral made by teachers, counselors, parents, or other interested persons according to the schedule below.
