- **Engage scholar (s) by asking them about interests**
- **Briefly explain the skill (the ability to understand written text) to the scholar (s)**
- **Break the skill into smaller and simpler steps**
- **Demonstrate or model (give an example of what is being taught) to the scholar (s)**
- **Allow scholars to practice the skill**
- **Offer your help in order for the scholar (s) to become ready to use the skill in actual situations**
- **Provide positive feedback and to help the scholar (s) to feel successful about learning and about themselves**
- **Correct any misunderstandings immediately**
- **Go over the steps so that the entire skill is develop**
