## **BAMMEL'S 2017-2018 DRESS CODE**

Dear Bammel Parents,

As we enter the beginning of this school year, our students will be required to adhere to our school dress code. Our school dress code will remain in effect until the last day of school. All students must wear their school uniform to school each and every day.

### **Bammel Elementary Dress Code**

- A long or short-sleeved **solid** red, white, or blue shirt (plain polo style with a collar) **ONLY**. Please see Main Office personnel if further clarification is needed.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Khaki or navy blue pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers (no higher than 3 inches above the knee) **ONLY**.
- Belts are required for students in grades 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>.
- **ON FRIDAYS ONLY**, students have a choice of wearing:
  - **Combination #1:** Jeans with a Bammel spirit shirt, **OR**
  - **Combination #2:** No jeans - Student will wear the regular school dress attire worn Monday – Thursday.

No mixing or matching. If your child chooses to wear jeans, he/she **MUST** wear a Bammel spirit shirt. If you child does not wear a Bammel spirit shirt, he/she **CANNOT** wear jeans, and must wear the regular dress code attire. If Combination #1 is worn, make sure that the jeans **DO NOT** have any holes or tears in them.

Spirit shirts will be available for purchase throughout the school year.

### **The following items ARE NOT a part of the dress code and are not permitted:**

- Mini-skirts, short jumpers, or short shorts (more than 3 inches above the knee)
- Cut-off shorts and pants that are torn with holes and rips in the material
- Leggings
- Spaghetti strap tops, undershirts, pajamas, tank tops, sagging pants (pants worn below the waistline), or muscle shirts
- Any article of clothing with pictures, designs (stripes, flowers, polka dots, animals, etc.), or writing (words) other than Bammel issued spirit shirts or attire.
- Face painting, press on tattoos, or writing on bodies
- Earrings (boys) or big hanging earrings (girls)
- Flip flops or any other open toe shoes
- Distracting hairstyles
  - Non-natural hair color (blue, green, orange, purple, rainbow, etc.)
  - Logos and other designs etched/parted in hair ( single side parts are acceptable)
  - High spiked hair (spikes over 2 inches high)

Students who violate the dress code will be given an opportunity to change into clothing that fits within the school dress code. At the discretion of the administrator, this may be clothing that the school provides and must be returned the following day (if available), or that parents/guardians bring them that day.

Thank you for your continued support with our efforts to be consistent in policy enforcement by sending your student to school in clothing that follows the Bammel Elementary School Dress Code.
