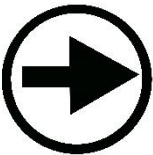


TCMS BULLYING INTERVENTION PLAN

Bullying occurs when a person is exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more other persons, and he or she has difficulty defending himself or herself. **Cyberbullying** is defined as bullying through the use of electronic communications, including a cellular or other telephone, computer, camera, email, instant messaging, text messaging, a social media application, an Internet website, or any other Internet-based communication.

- It is aggressive behavior that involves unwanted, negative actions.
- It involves a pattern of behavior repeated over time.
- It involves an imbalance of power or strength.

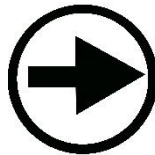

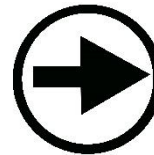

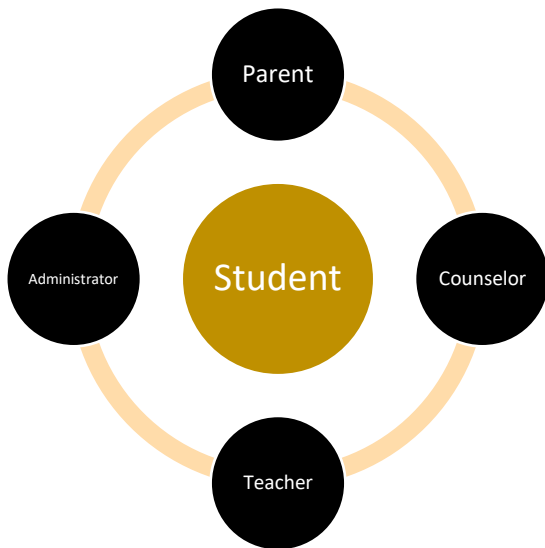
