Standardized Dress Code Policy

Heritage Elementary School's philosophy is to maintain a focus on the educational process and ensure the reduction of distractions and disruptions to the learning environment.

T-Shirts:

- Heritage spirit and college t-shirts are allowed on specific days.
- Heritage spirit t-shirts may be worn on **Fridays** only.
- College t-shirts may be worn on **Mondays** only.
- All t-shirts **MUST** be tucked in at all times.

Polo-Style Shirts:

- May be long or short sleeved.
- Must be red, white, or navy blue.
- Must be tucked in at all times.

Bottoms (Pants, Shorts, Skirts, and Jumpers):

- Must be khaki or blue pants **OR** denim jeans.
- Must be worn at the waist and fit snugly.
- May **NOT** be oversized, baggy, or sagging.
- Jeans with holes are **NOT** allowed.
- Must have a belt if bottoms have belt loops.

Shoes:

- Should provide adequate support and safety.
- Must be closed toe – sneakers or oxford-style.
- Flip flops, house shoes, and slippers are **NOT** allowed.
- Must not have wheels or rollers.

Grooming:

- Hair must be neat, clean, groomed, and must not distract or interfere with the learning environment. Hair extensions of a different color from the hair are **NOT** allowed.
- Male students may **NOT** wear earrings under any circumstance.
- Extreme hairstyles are not allowed.

Backpacks:

- Must be clear or mesh **ONLY**.
- No oversized purses are permitted.

Heritage Elementary School's administration reserves the right to make final decisions and revisions concerning the standardized dress code policy. If a student is out of dress code, his/her parents will be contacted to bring a change of clothes. Consequences will apply if the clothing is not changed.
