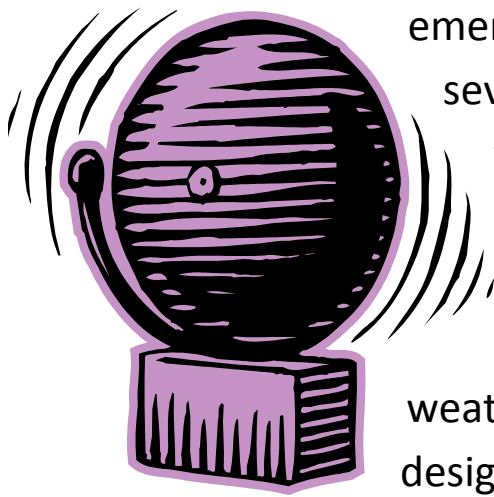


Drills & Procedures

We have district personnel that keep us informed of important regulations regarding crisis situations. If we ever have to respond to an emergency we want our students and staff to be well prepared. We have monthly drills to practice the routines for different types of



emergencies, such as fire, lock-down, and severe weather. You may at times come to the school and see a sign stating we are having a drill. You are expected to participate in the drills if you are in the building at that time. During severe weather, we have rooms/areas that are designated as *Safe*. If dangerous weather is

impending, all students will be moved to their assigned *safe* room or location. Students will not be released to go home, so please do not come to the school to check your student out during severe weather. We will be having monthly fire drills to practice the best way to exit the building in case of an emergency. We will also be having tornado and lockdown drills in the fall and spring. We work with students in advance to make sure these are not a surprise or scary.

In the event of an emergency, forcing school closure and student relocation, our children would be moved to Smith Elementary School.
