Dear Parents/Guardians,

Our standardized dress for the 2020-2021 school year will consist of the following:

## **Pants:**

- Khaki, navy blue or blue jeans (no ripped jeans or jeans with holes)
- Fitted at the waist
- Belted (if pants have loops)
- No oversized or baggy clothing as well as pants that are torn or worn.

## **Jumpers, Skirts or Shorts:**

- Khaki, navy blue or blue jeans (denim)
- Shorts should approach the knee
- Belted (if pants have loops)
- Jumpers should be solid (khaki, navy blue or denim), no appliques or designs

## **Shirts/Blouses:**

- Solid red, white or blue (Any other color is not part of our standardized dress)
- Long or short sleeves
- With or without collars
- School spirit shirt
- Shirts must be tucked in (unless it has a band like a sweatshirt)

## **Cold Weather Attire:**

- Sweatshirts, turtlenecks must be red, white or blue
- No sweatpants, no wind suits
- Leggings should be solid in color (red, white or navy), no appliques or designs and worn under a skirt of appropriate length.

## **Hair:**

- Must be clean and neat
- Must not be distracting or interfere with learning environment
- Male student's hair may not extend below the bottom of a sport shirt collar
- Afros may not be more than 2 inches long
- No Mohawks or etching that are distracting to the classroom environment

## **Shoes:**

- Students must wear appropriate shoes. Any enclosed shoe with a backing is permitted. Flip-flops or similar shoes are not permitted due to safety considerations as students walk the hallways.

## **Jewelry:**

- No oversized earrings, distracting jewelry, accessories with inappropriate messages
- Noisy or distracting jewelry or accessories may not be worn

A student in violation of dress code will be asked to contact their parent/guardian. In the event that a parent/guardian cannot be reached to remove a student from school to correct his/her grooming, the student may be placed in the Extension Center. Discipline consequences may also result from grooming code violations.
