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- In the event of continued Covid-19 Protocols, we will have already planned a schedule with the fewer transitions.
- The block schedule allows for greater flexibility with implementation of Carnegie Learning & Amplify
- The block schedule has decreased disciplinary infractions at the middle school level. Most major disciplinary infractions occur in the hallway during passing periods.
- The block schedule allows for controlled transitions at the middle school level. Since there are only 4 transitions, administrators can control each transition and ensure students are monitored as they change classes.
- The block schedule allows for uninterrupted instructional time. This makes it easier for teachers to have interventions and planned transitions.
