

## **Title I School-Wide Program 2018-2019 Guidelines for Parent Involvement**

In order to promote a partnership between the home and the school for improving the education of children, **Claughton Middle School** will implement programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents and/or caretakers. Such activities will be planned and implemented with meaningful consultation with parents. The consultation will be organized, systematic, ongoing, informed, and timely in relation to decisions about the program.

**To achieve this involvement, Claughton Middle School will implement the following requirements as described in “Improving America’s Schools Act of 1994” – Public Law 103-382**

- **Claughton Middle** – In the beginning of the school year, a Parental Informational Meeting will be held. This meeting will outline how parents, the entire campus staff, and the student will share the responsibility for improved student achievement and the means by which school and parents will build and develop a partnership to help the student achieve the state’s high performance standards (STAAR). The parent will be informed of the reasons of their child’s participation in the program and the specific instructional objectives and methods that will be utilized to help the student reach the expected level of proficiency.
- **Claughton Middle** – will offer a flexible number of meetings for Title I parents, such as meetings in the evening, in order to maximize the number of participating parents. The purpose of these meetings is to guide parents to work effectively with their child at home.
- **Parents** - will be informed in a timely fashion about all aspects of **Claughton’s Title I Educational Programs** through parent conferences, the marquee, parent connect, via-email and flyers mailed to parents.
- **Parents** - are encouraged to observe in their child’s classroom by scheduling a time to visit throughout the year. Our goal also includes work sessions by teachers for the parents during the day within the child’s classroom.
- **Our school** counselor/parent involvement coordinator will coordinate the parent involvement activities. The Campus Advisory Committee is committed to providing many more activities within the CIP to involve all of our parents in the academic aspects of our school.
- **A Title I Parent** will be a part of the Title I Committee at Claughton Middle School in order to provide input regarding:
  - a) **Title I Program-** planning, implementation, evaluation and improvement
  - b) **Parent Involvement-** effectiveness as well as need for improvement
  - c) **Budget** – Review expenditures, suggestions for improvement, etc.
