Greetings Parents and Students,

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year at Roberson Middle School! Thank you for entrusting us with the care of your scholars. We are excited to have them back on campus, and want to ensure a smooth transition into the new year.

Student and staff safety is a priority. We definitely want to make sure that this is evident in our car rider line. Our goal is to ensure a steady flow, so we are implementing the following procedures at RMS (*Special Note: We load 16 - 20 vehicles at a time):

- As you enter the parking lot, adhere to the posted speed limit.
- Without exception, all students must be picked up in the car rider line.
 - You may not park and walk up to pick up your child.
- We have 2 lanes of traffic to pick up students.
 - Choose either lane A closest to the building or lane B located closest to the parking lot.
 - After choosing a lane, you must stay in the same lane (No lane changes).
- Follow the direction of staff who are directing traffic and students.
- Your child will be standing in line as you arrive.
- Staff will send your child towards the front of the car rider line when they see your vehicle (car/truck)
 - When all of the vehicles (cars/trucks) are stopped, your child will be sent to your vehicle.
- Please follow the flow of traffic and only stop to pick up your child if the line is completely stopped.
 - If there are no cars in front of you, do not stop until you reach the front of the line.
 - Staff are responsible for maintaining the flow of traffic.
