**Students who entered 9th grade in 2014-2015 and beyond have one graduation program, The Foundation High School Program. The students have an opportunity to earn enhancements to the program which includes Endorsements, Distinguished Level of Achievement, and/or Performance Acknowledgements. Students must meet End of Course (EOC) requirements to graduate. See your school counselors for detailed information on graduation requirements.
