When figuring the number of days accrued, only count calendar work days (that does NOT include winter break, spring break etc..)

## How much will my checks be when I return to work?

- Take the # of days you have remaining of your contract to work
- Multiply that # by your daily rate
- We divide that amount by the number of checks you have remaining for the year
