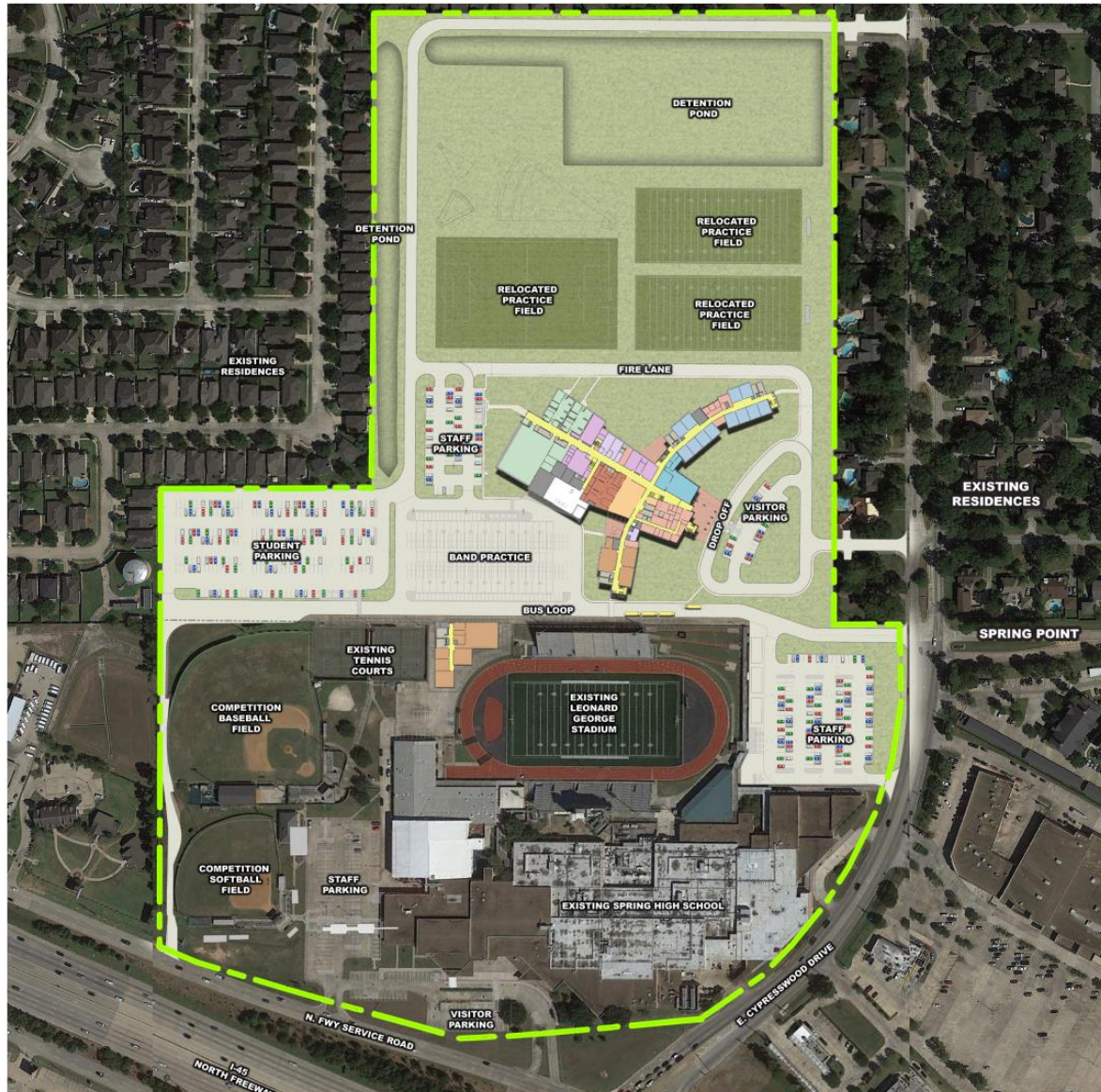

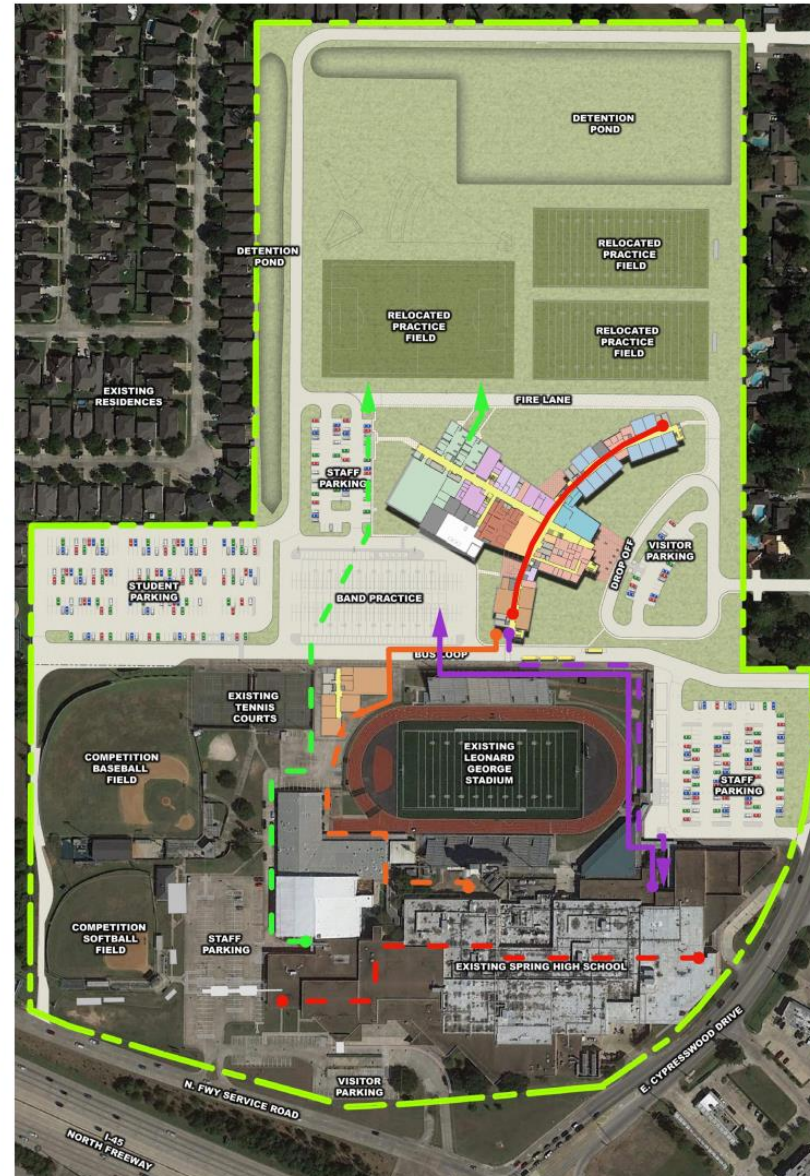

## TRAFFIC STUDY LEGEND

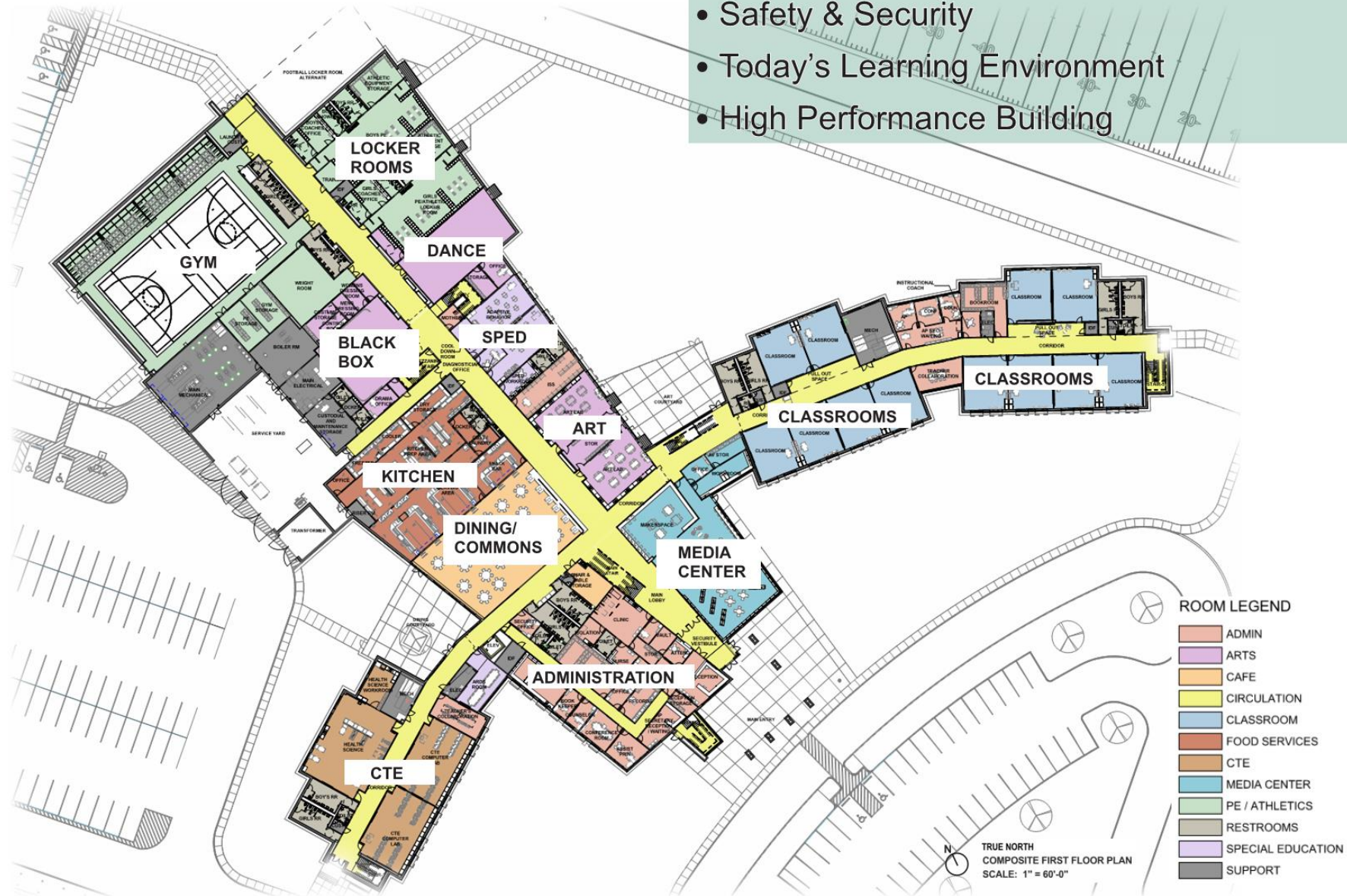
2,640 FEET WALKING = 10 MINUTES

- One side of High School to the other 979 Feet (4 Minutes)
- One side of 9th Grade Center to the other 606 Feet (2 Minutes)
- 9th Grade Center to Fine Arts 870 Feet (4 Minutes)
- Fine Arts to Band Practice Area 975 Feet (4 Minutes)
- High School Athletics Locker Rooms to Practice Fields 1,401 Feet (6 Minutes)
- 9th Grade Locker Rooms to Practice Fields 163 Feet (1 Minute)
- High School to ROTC Building 792 Feet (3 Minutes)
- 9th Grade to ROTC Building 566 Feet (2 Minutes)

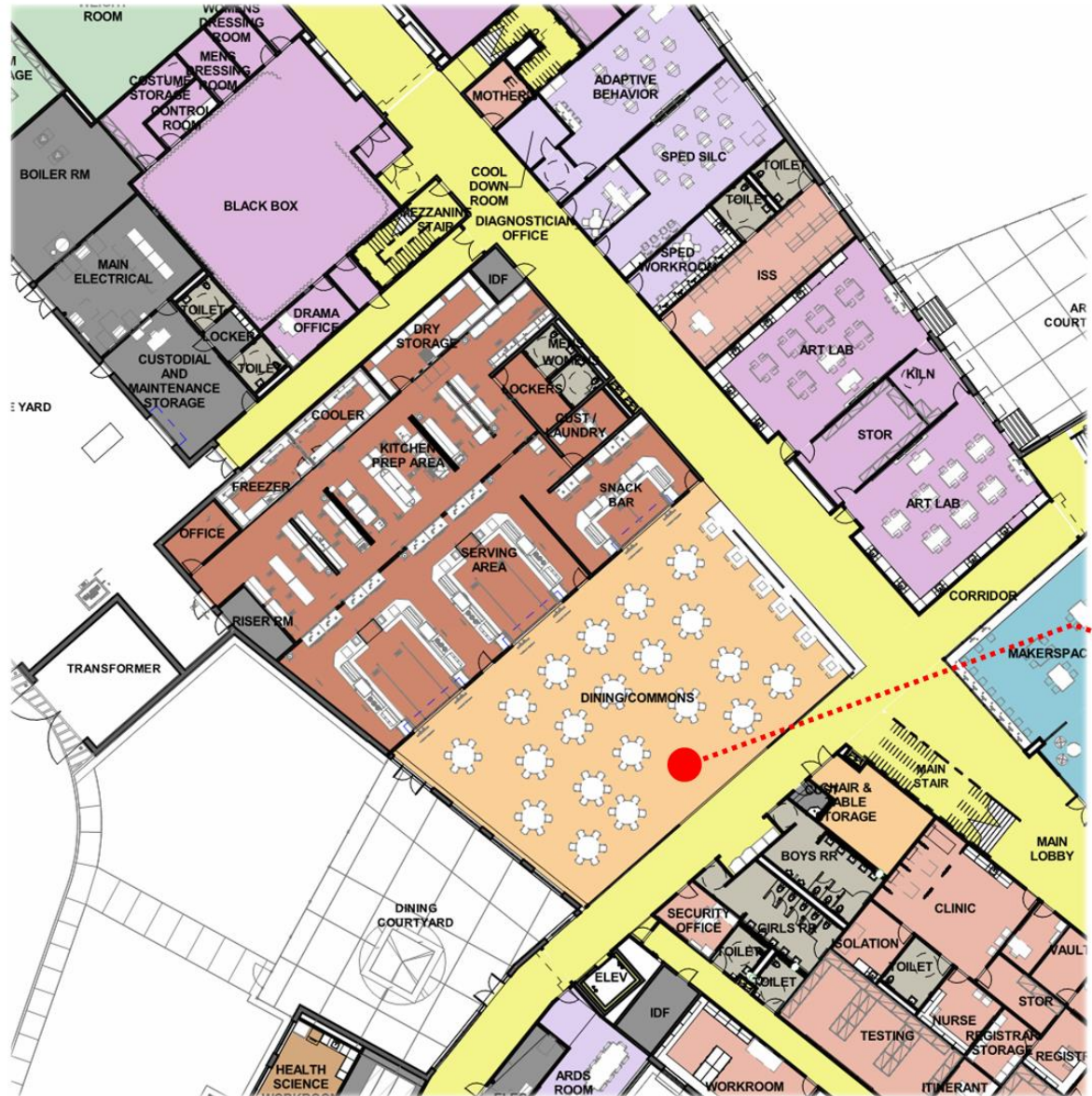

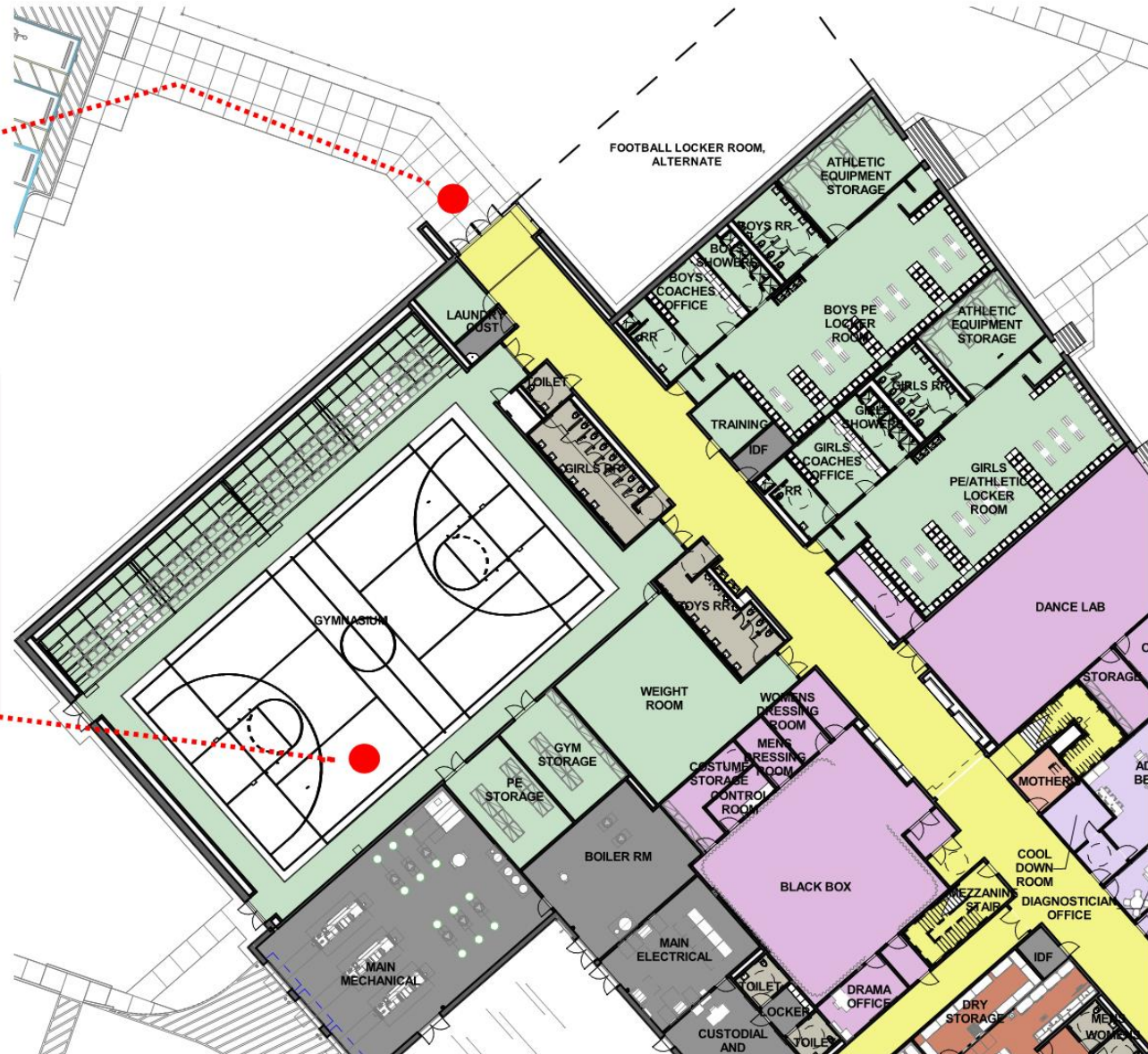

## RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (ROTC) VIEW OF FRONT ENTRY



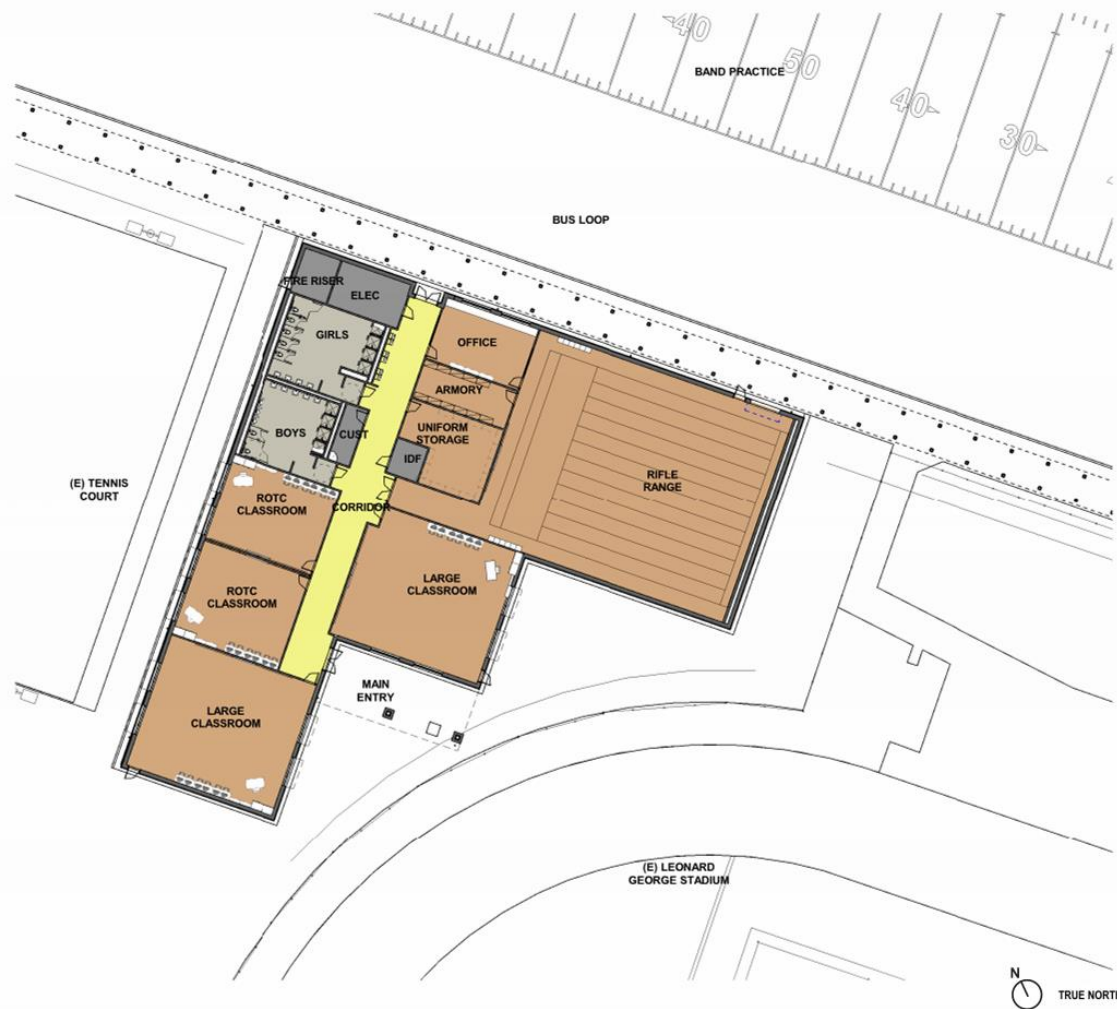


## RESERVED OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (ROTC) FLOOR PLAN

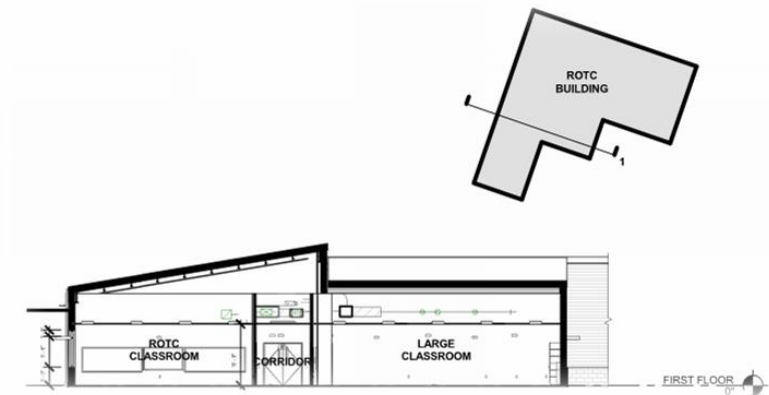
