

Fine Arts and Physical Education

In accordance with local district policy, the required physical education credit may be earned through completion of any TEKS-based course that meets the requirement of this paragraph for 100 minutes of moderate to vigorous physical activity per five-day school week and ***that is not being used to satisfy another specific graduation requirement.***

A student may take Dance I to fulfill the fine arts requirement.

OR

If the Dance I course meets the above requirements for physical activity, the same Dance I course could fulfill the physical education credit requirement.

Fine Arts and Physical Education

COURSES

- Band I-IV
- Dance I-IV
- Eligible for fine arts credit
- In accordance with local policy, eligible for PE substitution credit if the activity meets the moderate to vigorous physical activity requirements, and is not being used to satisfy another graduation requirement.

ACTIVITY

- Marching Band
- Dance Team/Drill Team
- Cheerleading
- In accordance with local policy, eligible for PE substitution credit if the activity meets the moderate to vigorous physical activity requirements
