

A student who becomes a nonresident may complete their senior year at a District high school if the student's parents move after the junior year and the student attended the District school during the sophomore and junior years. The following are procedures for District students on a tuition basis:

1. Full tuition will be paid by the parents unless a state-approved transfer has been obtained for the student.
2. Only the local portion of the tuition will be paid by the parents if a state-approved transfer has been obtained for the student.

Students whose parents present evidence that the family will be moving into the District may be enrolled without payment of tuition for ten school days. Full tuition shall be paid for any school days attended beyond the first ten school days until the family becomes official residents of the District. Enrollment under these conditions is valid for up to 90 calendar days only.

Students whose parents are nonresident staff members of the District may attend a District school at a nominal tuition rate established annually by the Board and by filing a completed application for state-approved transfer with the Superintendent's office prior to May 1 of the next school year. A hardship transfer may be applied for by a staff member residing out of the District who is hired after May 1.
