I. Call to Order

II. Closed Session: Consider, hear, deliberate, and obtain legal advice on Board Policy DFBB Nonrenewal Hearing of Mark Rambis, under the following sections of the Texas Government Code:

III. Consideration, Hearing, and Possible Action on Board Policy DFBB Nonrenewal Hearing of Mark Rambis
